MICHAEL LLOYD CONDUCTOR

Michael Lloyd was appointed Music Director and Chief Conductor of the Birmingham Philharmonic Orchestra in March 1994 after several years of active association as a guest conductor. He is a native of Worcestershire and read music at the University of East Anglia in Norwich, followed by further study at the Royal College of Music in London. He joined Scottish Ballet as company pianist and it was with this company that he began conducting, with performances of Nutcracker, Giselle, La Sylphide, and other short ballets.

In 1972 Michael joined the Staatstheater Kassel, initially as ballet conductor and pianist; but after only one season was offered a post on the opera staff. He made his opera debut there as well as forming a piano trio and becoming Chorus Master of the Kasseler Konzertchor.

In 1980 Michael Lloyd moved to Stuttgart where he continued his operatic conducting and working regularly with the Stuttgart Philharmonische Vokale Ensemble, the Sudddeutscher Madrigalchor, and the South German Radio Chorus. He remained active in chamber music and as a continuo player, appeared regularly with the Ludwigsburg Festival Orchestra. In 1985 Michael joined the music staff at ENO where he has conducted regularly at the Coliseum. In June 1990 he participated in the Company's highly successful tour of the USSR.

Outside the Coliseum, Michael Lloyd has conducted in Japan, Korea and New Zealand and has participated in a wide range of concerts in London where he also teaches regularly at the Opera School of the RCM. In addition to his BPO role, he is also the Music Director and 'Principal' Conductor of the Chandos Symphony Orchestra, Malvern.
