MICHAEL LLOYD

WAS APPOINTED MUSIC DIRECTOR AND CHIEF CONDUCTOR OF THE BIRMINGHAM PHILHARMONIC ORCHESTRA IN MARCH 1994 AFTER SEVERAL YEARS OF ACTIVE ASSOCIATION AS A GUEST CONDUCTOR. HE IS A NATIVE OF WORCESTERSHIRE AND READ MUSIC AT THE UNIVERSITY OF EAST ANGLIA IN NORWICH, FOLLOWED BY FURTHER STUDY AT THE ROYAL COLLEGE OF MUSIC IN LONDON. HE

JOINED SCOTTISH BALLET AS COMPANY PIANIST AND IT WAS WITH THIS COMPANY THAT HE BEGAN CONDUCTING BALLETS. IN 1972 MICHAEL JOINED THE STAATSTHEATER KASSEL, INITIALLY AS BALLET CONDUCTOR AND PIANIST, BUT AFTER ONLY ONE SEASON WAS OFFERED A POST ON THE OPERA STAFF AND MADE HIS OPERA DEBUT THERE. IN 1980 MICHAEL LLOYD MOVED TO STUTTGART WHERE HE CONTINUED HIS OPERATIC CONDUCTING AND WORKED REGULARLY WITH LOCAL CHORAL AND ORCHESTRAL ENSEMBLES. IN 1985 MICHAEL LLOYD JOINED THE MUSIC STAFF AT ENGLISH NATIONAL OPERA WHERE HE HAS CONDUCTED REGULARLY AT THE COLISEUM AND ON TOUR. OUTSIDE THE COLISEUM, MICHAEL HAS CONDUCTED IN JAPAN, KOREA AND NEW ZEALAND

AND HAS PARTICIPATED IN A WIDE RANGE OF CONCERTS IN LONDON WHERE HE ALSO TEACHES REGULARLY AT THE OPERA SCHOOL OF THE RCM. SINCE 1995 MICHAEL HAS VERY SUCCESSFULLY PERFORMED MANY MAJOR WORKS WITH THE BPO, AND THIS SEASON'S PROGRAMMING CONTINUES TO OFFER CHALLENGING AND EXCITING MUSIC. IN ADDITION TO HIS BPO ROLE, MICHAEL LLOYD IS ALSO THE MUSIC DIRECTOR AND PRINCIPAL CONDUCTOR OF THE CHANDOS SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA, MALVERN.

JEREMY SILVER



STUDIED AT CLARE COLLEGE, CAMBRIDGE, THE ROYAL COLLEGE OF MUSIC, THE NATIONAL OPERA STUDIO AND WITH GEORGE HURST. HE WAS PRINCIPAL CONDUCTOR OF THE ISLINGTON SINFONIA, MUSIC DIRECTOR OF THE UMDS CHOIR & ORCHESTRA AND HAS

BEEN A REGULAR CONDUCTOR WITH THE SURREY SINFONIETTA. IN 1993 JEREMY JOINED THE STAFF OF SCOTTISH OPERA WHERE HE SPENT THREE YEARS. WHILST IN GLASGOW HE WAS MUSIC DIRECTOR OF THE AWARD-WINNING OPERA ON A SHOESTRING. JEREMY HAS NOW JOINED THE MUSIC STAFF OF ENGLISH NATIONAL OPERA AND IS ALSO MUSIC DIRECTOR OF CAMBERWELL POCKET OPERA, GIVING SMALL-SCALE PERFORMANCES OF OPERA AROUND THE COUNTRY.

MICHAEL SAVAGE



WAS A BOY CHORISTER AT EXETER CATHEDRAL AND HAS BEEN SINGING IN CHOIRS AND ON THE STAGE EVER SINCE. HE CONDUCTED HIS FIRST CHOIR IN 1955 AND HAS STUDIED UNDER MANY DISTINGUISHED CONDUCTORS SUCH AS SIR DAVID WILLCOCKS, ANTHONY HOPKINS AND PHILIP CRANMER. OVER THE PAST 40 YEARS HE HAS CONDUCTED, AND

IN SOME CASES FOUNDED, A WIDE RANGE OF CHORAL GROUPS, AND TOOK OVER THE MUSICAL DIRECTION OF THE SOLIHULL CHANDOS CHOIR IN 1987. FORMED 30 YEARS AGO, THIS LIVELY AND GROWING CHOIR HAS

OVER 100 MEMBERS AND PERFORMS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR AT A WIDE RANGE OF VENUES IN THE UK AND ABROAD.

STEPHEN DODSWORTH



COMMENCED HIS CAREER IN MUSIC IN POCKLINGTON IN EAST YORKSHIRE. WHILST LIVING THERE, HE FORMED AN "A CAPELLA" CHOIR AND ORCHESTRA AND RAN A FLOURISHING CHAMBER MUSIC SOCIETY. IN 1989 HE WAS APPOINTED DIRECTOR OF MUSIC AT KING EDWARD VI SCHOOL IN STRATFORD-UPON-AVON AND IN THE FOLLOWING

YEAR BECAME CONDUCTOR OF THE STRATFORD-UPON-AVON CHORAL SOCIETY. FORMED IN 1836, THE SOCIETY, WITH A MEMBERSHIP OF ABOUT 100, SHARES WITH THE HUDDERSFIELD CHORAL SOCIETY THE DISTINCTION OF BEING ONE OF THE OLDEST CHORAL SOCIETIES IN BRITAIN. IT GIVES THREE CONCERTS A YEAR IN STRATFORD AND MAKES EUROPEAN TOURS EVERY TWO OR THREE YEARS.
